## **YOUTH WEEKEND 2018**

## Please note the following Rules:

- Class entries do not attract a fee, however riders & horses must have attended all relevant sessions at the Training Day on 18 January 2018 in order to be eligible to compete in the Classes entered.
- 2. All horses must be registered with the National Saddle Horse Register of SHCA and all owners/part-owners must be current financial members of an Affiliate of SHCA.
- 3. Age of rider is as at the date of the event.
- 4. SHCA Competition & General Rules apply please bear this in mind when entering Rider Classes.
- 5. All competitors and Responsible Officers are required to be current financial members of an Affiliate of the SHCA.
- 6. No rider may compete on more than two (2) horses at this event.
- 7. During both the Training Day & the Championship Show the rider entered to compete on the horse must be the only person to ride said horse for the duration of the event.
- 8. Winners of Classes 109 to 115 and Classes 208 to 211 are eligible for entry in relevant Childrens Day Classes at the 2019 Grand National.
- 9. The winner & 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetter of Rider Classes 108, 205, 206 & 207 are eligible for entry in the relevant Rider Classes at the 2019 Grand National.
- 10. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- 11. Drug testing may be carried out at this Event.
- 12. First Ridden Ponies:

In SHC Grand National or Grand National Qualifier Competitions, ponies in First Ridden Open OR Show Hunter Classes shall be NSH registered. Owner/Exhibitor/s & Rider shall be Current SHC member/s.

- 1. Ponies not to exceed 12.2hh
- 2. Age of rider to be 5yrs & under 12yrs on day of the Show.
- 3. Ponies to be ridden in a simple snaffle bridle.
- 4. No cantering is allowed on the circle together, however a short canter is allowed in the individual performance back to the judge.
- 5. Ponies must enter or leave the Ring at a walk or a trot.
- 6. This class should be judged for the suitability of the pony for the purpose intended.
- 7. A narrow strap may be attached to the front of the saddle.
- 8. Snaffle bit must be used in First Ridden classes.
