#### 24/7 COVER

Provides 24/7 cover while competing at Show Horse Council of Australasia sanctioned events and in non-income earning equestrian activities, relating only to Show Horse Council Australasia events, provided the member/s have paid their membership.

Cover is **NOT** provided when you are:

- X Participating at an event organised by another club or association
- X Outside of a sanctioned event and earning an income from the activity
- X Participating in events not related to Show Horse Council Australasia Inc.
- X A Day Member
